## **Proposal**

We propose to add two new emoji symbols of popular winter activities: sleigh and curling.

The frequencies in Google Trends and Instagram posts are based on the number of "ice hockey". (i.e. Freq. of ice hockey is 1.00.)

#### **Factors for Inclusion**

#### A: Compatibility

For most of the proposed characters it is easy to create an image that is distinct from existing characters in Unicode and communicates the intended associations.

#### **D: Completeness**

#### F: Overly specific

Each emoji character represents general category of winter activities as well as existing emojis, ski, skate, snowboard, ice hockey, etc.

#### G: Open-ended

Sleigh is a generic vehicle to be used for multiple usages including winter sports. Curling is one of popular winter sports frequently represented as pictograms for international sports competitions (<u>image search for "winter sports pictgrams"</u>) as well as other existing sports emoji characters.

# **Evidence of Frequency**



The Y axis starts from 0 and increases linearly.


