

Additional Variation Selectors for Rotations of Ancient Egyptian Hieroglyphic Texts

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Executive Summary

This document requests the addition of 44 new sequences for Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphs to be included in StandardizedVariants.txt in Unicode version 17.0.

Background documents

- [L2/22-012R](#) is an earlier proposal for the registration of rotations for Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphs
- [L2/21-248](#) is an earlier proposal that defined the usage of VS1–VS3 for Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphs and suggested to reserve VS4–VS7 for non-90° rotations.
- [L2/24-177](#) is an earlier proposal that included the usage of VS4 and VS7 for Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphs.
- [L2/22-012](#) is the earlier proposal, for which this proposal is a follow-up/update.

Introduction

In Unicode v5.2 certain rotated variants of hieroglyphs were introduced that do not justify a separate codepoint because these rotated variants have the same function as the unrotated base characters, e.g. U+133DC EGYPTIAN HIEROGLYPH Y001A (vertical form of Y1) (𐦎) as a variant of the more common U+133DB EGYPTIAN HIEROGLYPH Y001 (papyrus rolled up, tied, and sealed) (𐦎).

At the same time, there is a clear demand from Egyptologists to encode these very common cases of rotations in hieroglyphic strings.

In general, it was decided to implement non-meaningful rotations of Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphs in Unicode via Variation Selectors (see [L2/21-248](#)).

Use of Variation Selectors in the Newly Requested Variation Sequences

Variation Selectors VS1–VS3 have already been defined to represent cases of 90°, 180° and 270° clockwise (if LTR) rotation of hieroglyphs. In accordance with the original proposal [L2/21-248](#), we requested additional VSes for ‘odd’ angles in the four quarters. The proposal [L2/24-177](#) requested VS4

(FE03) and VS7 (FE06) for rotations between 15° and 75° and 285° and 345°, respectively. This proposal requests the usage of VS5 (FE04) and VS6 (FE05) to be used in cases of rotations between 105° and 165° and 195° and 255°, respectively.

Newly Proposed Sequences

The proposed variants are rotations of hieroglyphs found in digital hieroglyphic text databases encoded in Manuel de Codage/JSesh or Manuel de Codage/WinGlyph from the *Thesaurus Linguae Aegyptiae* database (BBAW Berlin, Daniel A. Werning; <https://thesaurus-linguae-egyptiae.de>), *Pyramid Text* encoding project (Frank Kammerzell, Daniel A. Werning), *Karnak Project* database (Sébastien Biston-Moulin; <http://sith.huma-num.fr/>), *Athribis project* encodings (Christian Leitz, Carolina Teotino), *Kom Ombo project* encodings (Françoise Labrique, Sven Eicke), and data tables by Michel Suignard.

Lists of candidates for possible rotations were discussed in a larger group with Peter Dils, Jorke Grotenhuis, Svenja Gülden, Stéphane Polis, Mark-Jan Nederhof (and Daniel A. Werning). Certain candidates in discussion were held back for further investigation.

Description of rotations in StandardizedVariants.txt Code




We anticipate that the exact angle of the basic glyphs which the rotated variants are based on may slightly vary in actual fonts, e.g., the exact angles of 1312F () , 1319D () , 13205 () , 1332B () , 13BE8 () , or 14274 () . To prevent that two specific cases of rotation end up close to vertical after the rotation, namely 1312F FE03 () , and 13205 FE03 () , an extra hint "[but not yet vertical]" was added to the description. For a similar reason hints "[vertical]" and "[horizontal]" point to the actually intended appearance.
