The UTC (*Unicode Technical Committee*) and other experts in the US have been involved in the following standardization-related activities since IRG Meeting #63 took place:

- 1. The Unicode Version 17.0 Alpha Review was issued as PRI #514 that began on 2025-02-04, and will close on 2025-04-02. The following are some noteworthy additions:
 - Five characters were added to the Ideographic Symbols and Punctuation block (U+16FF2 through U+16FF6).
 - Five urgently-needed ideographs were appended to the CJK Unified Ideographs Extension C block (U+2B73A through U+2B73E).
 - 4,298 ideographs were added in the new CJK Unified Ideographs Extension J block (U+323B0 through U+33479).
 - Four Standardized Variation Sequences (SVSes) for the Sibe (aka Mongolian) forms of the four quotation marks — U+2018, U+2019, U+201C, and U+201D — that use VS3 (*Variation Selector 3* or U+FE02) were added.
- 2. Also see PRI #508 (Proposed Updated UAX #38) and PRI #513 (Proposed Update UAX #50) for information about proposed changes to those Unicode Standard Annexes.
- 3. A UNC proposal for two script-hybrid Han ideographs was submitted as document IRG N2789. If accepted, the proposed code points would fill the CJK Unified Ideographs Extension D block.
- 4. UTC experts reviewed and submitted comments against the UTC-assigned portion of IRG Working Set 2024 Version 2.0, specifically serial numbers 01144 through 02333, prior to the 2025-02-07 deadline, and will have responded to comments against UTC-submitted ideographs by the 2025-03-14 deadline.
- 5. The UTC CJK & Unihan Working Group, which reports to the UTC, continues to meet approximately three weeks prior to each quarterly UTC meeting. See documents L2/24-227R and L2/25-009 for the CJK & Unihan Working Group recommendations that were prepared for the UTC Meetings #181 and #182, respectively. As a reminder, IRG experts are welcome to join the CJK & Unihan Working Group, which meets four times per year as a virtual (Webex) meeting. The next CJK & Unihan Working Group meeting, in preparation for the UTC Meeting #183, is scheduled to take place on 2025-04-04 from 6 to 9PM PDT (GMT Minus 7).
