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1. CJK_C1 review and versions

As decided by CJK_C1 group at IRG#25, Berkeley, there are 5,000 characters are selected for CJK_C1_v60. The selected characters had been review for more than 3 rounds before IRG#25 and never been questioned.

The IDS attributes were added to the selected 5,000 characters for easy finding similar glyphs when reviewing CJK_C1_v60 and v61.

Two rounds of review took place between IRG#25 and IRG#26, the latest version of CJK_C1 is v61, i.e., IRGN1194.

2. Comments to the latest version of CJK_C1

Japan requests to withdraw 1 J-source character (IRGN 1198).

Macao lists 3 M-source characters which they think should not be unified to others; Macao also lists 3 “missing” characters (IRGN1202).

Note: the 3 “missing” characters had ever been questioned, thus, they are removed according to rules set by CJK_C1 group at IRG#25 (IRGN1179).

DPRK lists 2 KP-source characters which they think should not be unified to others; DPRK also lists 33 “missing” characters (IRGN 1201).

Note: the 33 “missing” characters had ever been questioned, thus, they are removed according to rules set by CJK_C1 group at IRG#25 (IRGN1179).

China asks IRG to consider her request of re accepting 1,195 G-source characters to CJK_C1 (IRGN xxxx).
