### 1. Review of CJK\_C in PDAM4 of ISO/IEC10646

Chinese editors reviewed the code charts of CJK\_C in PDAM4 of ISO/IEC10646 and submitted their comments to the SC2 balloting. These comments were reviewed and discussed at WG2#50 by WG2 experts, including representatives of some IRG members (China, Japan, Vietnam and TCA) and IRG rapporteur. ### 2. Old hanzi submission

As required by IRG#27, Chinese old hanzi experts and editors met in Beijing and finished a list of 312 oracle bone inscriptions. For details, read IRGN1307 please.

### 3. Fonts of CJK\_D

Following IRG resolution M27.5, G-source TrueType fonts of CJK\_D are ready. The current font base contains all G-source characters in CJK\_C and CJK\_D, it will be refined soon when CJK\_D "mapping table" is concrete.

### 4. GB dot matrix fonts of CJK ideographs

As usual, a font making team is developing various sizes of dot matrix fonts (such as 24×24, 48×48, etc.) for CJK\_C ideographs, these fonts will be released as national standards (GB) in future. At

the same time, the released GB dot matrix fonts of CJK, CJK\_A and CJK\_B are checked again and being corrected for some errors. The development of GB dot matrix fonts of CJK\_D is planned.

When developing GB dot matrix fonts, some possible errors and more needs in CJK unification rules are found and raised by the font making team. A list of these possible errors and needs is being prepared and will be ready later for IRG references.
