Japan's concern on the PDAM4 ballot comment disposition regarding CJK extension C and suggestion to continue reviewing for PDAM5 ballot

Introduction

As the result of PDAM4 ballot, WG2 recognized that CJK extension C still have problems on its quality and decided moving it into PDAM5. Consequently the schedule of the CJK extension C will delay at least 6 month. Ballot for PDAM5 is already opened and will be closed in August.

During the last WG2 meeting in April, IRG rapporteur submitted the disposition of comment against CJK extension C (WG2 N3267) with input from IRG member editors. WG2 made modifications as written in the document and included the revised draft in PDAM5. WG2 also expects IRG to continue reviewing on the CJK extension C to gain more quality and IRG should make effort until the ballot will be closed so that not to delay more.

Japan keeps studying on the CJK extension C after the last WG2 meeting, and has found some problems. This document reports about such questions for discussion. Japan will include them as a part of the ballot comment on PDAM5 unless the problems are resolved.

1. Questions on WG2 N3267

[u-2aeef] No change

This character was in CJK C1 v5.2D (IRG N1151) so it cannot be included in the CJK C candidates as resolved in M25.4 (i.e. unstable character). It should be deleted.

[u-2b642] No change

Referring to the input from Vietnam on 6 Apr. 2007, the glyph should be changed ? Need confirmation by Vietnam.

2. Other questions


2.1 another unstable characters
