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After reviewing IRG N1298 “Results of IDS check and comments”, we found that there are 20 unification candidates in Macao characters submitted to CJK D.

By further reviewing those 20 characters, Macao SAR would like to request IRG to consider **KEEPING** the following **FIVE (5)** characters, **NOT** to be unified, as their glyphs are quite different from the possibly unifiable characters suggested in IRGN1298. Moreover, they are currently used in person's names in Macao public departments.
