#### 1. Review of CJK\_Dv21

Chinese editors reviewed the CJK\_Dv21, they focused on questioned characters in D set in this round, they are now preparing “evidences” of all G source characters for next meeting.

#### 2. Old hanzi meeting and submission

As required by IRG#28, old hanzi experts from Beijing Normal University (北京師範大學) finished selecting oracle glyphs of Shuowen Jiezi (說文解字) radical 101 to 140. The list is submitted to IRG#29 with document number IRGN1355.

On 2007-09-13 to 15, the old hanzi experts from China and TCA met in Harbin. The report was already submitted to IRG.

#### 3. Urgently needed characters

As agreed at IRG#28, Chinese editors prepared a proposal (IRGN1366) containing 5,751 characters used in ID system and electronically processed ancient books.

#### 4. *Specified Hanzi List*

The new *Specified Hanzi List* (規範漢字表) is almost finished by the Ministry of Education. This list collects 9,077 hanzi, most of them had been already issued to public in the *General Purpose*

***Hanzi List for Modern Chinese Language*** (G7 現代漢語通用字表). The Ministry of Education is now collecting comments from related governmental departments and related organizations.

5. Chinese delegation attended the WG2#51 in Hangzhou in this September.
