1. Korea national body activities

Korea national body members made an effort to get new characters that is not included in Unicode and Korean standards from the project named 'Korean History Online Database' carried out until 2007. We have collected about 2,300 characters and made a list of new characters that include an source information. We will suggest this list as 'Urgent Need characters'.

KIRG members are also investigating han characters native in Korea used in old scores, traditional mathematical books and the books related to the science of divination. We are doing that work with the 'Character Codes Research Center' in Korea University.

2. Recent Activities

KIRG members are preparing the investigation plan about the han characters for personal names and place names. KIRG have some plan to communicate with the related institutions and the information technology companies. KIRG and related institutions will be expected to carry out the project related to han characters for personal names and place names together.
