

Note of CJK_Dv30_MultiDrictions

All items are marked in different colors.

- Green: These items were discussed at IRG#29 and will be corrected according to conclusions. Some single source characters will be deleted per requests of their original submitters.
- Red: These items had not been discussed and will be kept in D set for discussion.
- Yellow: These items were not discussed at IRG#29 but were agreed to be corrected according to original comments double checked by the IRG Chief Editor.

The CJK_Dv30_MultiDrictions is recorded in an excel file, it contains 5 sheets.

- Unification:
 - Some items marked in yellow need confirmation of the character submitters, no response implies to accept the conclusions.
 - Some items were agreed to be postponed to be discussed with Annex S, they will be put to D set if no agreement among editors. (I do not remember details of every item, so please let me know if there was any conclusion at IRG#29.)
 - Only postponed characters will be moved to D set, other characters will be moved to M set or be deleted.
- Miscellaneous
 - The missing M source characters will be added to M set.
 - Other characters will be kept in D set.
- From CJK_C
 - 2 G source only characters will be deleted per request of China.
 - Other characters will be kept in D set.
- Attributes
 - Items of radical issues marked “not discussed” (in red) will be kept in D set, because radical issues are more important than other issues and need more discussion.
 - All other items will be added to M set.
 - For SC and FS items, I suggest TCA to accept HKSAR comments because the related IRG documents are referred to their comments and are seemed reasonable.
- Questionable glyph
 - All items will be kept in D set.

Note 2 of CJK_Dv30_MultiDrictions

This note is supplement to the previous one.

The file "CJK_Dv30_MultiDrictions.xls" was modified according to comments from Japan, Vietnam and TCA by 2008-02-04.

Modifications according to Japanese comments

1. Clarification of some "terminologies":

Postpone: This character should be moved to CJK_D D set for more discussion.

Move to E: This character should be removed from CJK_D, and may be submitted to CJK_E.

Delete: This character should be removed from CJK_D, and may NOT be submitted to CJK_E.

Drop: This character should be removed from CJK_D, and may NOT be submitted to CJK_E.

Withdraw: This character should be removed from CJK_D, and may NOT be submitted to CJK_E.

I did not unify these "terminologies" to avoid making more errors when editing this file.

2. TCA "fish" cases:

All 5 TCA "fish" cases are moved to CJK_D D set for more discussion, since no unanimous agreement reached at IRG#29.

3. Annex S related cases:

04095 JMK65328 236DB not unifiable

06551 G_zjw01434 2B178 unifiable

These and "fish" cases are related to Annex S, I'll forward them to Mr. John Knightly for discussion at IRG#30.

4. CJK_B fonts:

It is found that fonts of U+26C9E and U+2B33F are wrong. The font vendor is Zhongyi Co., if I remember correctly. I'll contact them.

5. More explanation or information of some G characters:

Some G characters are removed to D set. **China** is required to prepare document(s) for more explanation or information of these characters by **IRG#30**.

6. movement of one item:

09562 is moved to sheet "Miscellaneous". This character is kept in M set.

Macao asked to dis-unify M character and T character, but IRG#29 editorial meeting rejected it. IRG#29 editorial meeting thought that the glyph differences could be reflected by multi-column code charts.

7. Corrections:

01248 is moved to D set as requested by Japan.

09169 is moved to D set as agreed at IRG#29, but the "conclusion" is corrected, Japan indicated that it is not a "fish" case.

Modifications according to Vietnamese comments

1. Confirmation of attributes:

No change to related "conclusion" because Vietnamese feedback confirmed the suggestions.

2. Questionable glyphs:

Vietnam provided explanations of 3 glyphs. These items are still kept in D set because they were not discussed at IRG#29. I suggest **Vietnam and other IRG members** to provide more clear fonts, if needed.

Modifications according to TCA's comments

It seems that TCA's comments are not for "CJK_Dv30_MultiDrictions.xls", I suggest TCA to check and resubmit them for next version of CJK_D.

Other issues

For "place wrong" characters, I suggest to correct them when finalizing CJK_D, not this time.

Directions to IRG Technical Editor

Besides M set and D set of CJK_Dv30, please make a **list** showing all characters (and their comments) taken back to M set. This list will help us to find the discussed items and save our time in future.
