This paper directs how to generate CJK_Dv40 M set and D set.

- The CJK_Dv40 consists of M set and D set.
- The excel file consists of 6 parts (comments submitted after the last round of review but before IRG#30 are consolidated):
 - Unification: Pairs are not discussed at IRG#30, will be kept in D set. Character submitters are required to provide more explanation if they do not agree the unification proposal.
 - Miscellaneous: All characters will be moved to M set with or without correction by the IRG Technical Editor, according to conclusion or direction at IRG#30.
 - From CJK_C: All characters are originally from CJK_C and are never discussed, will be kept in D set.
 - Attributes: Some characters will be moved to M set with KX, SC, FS and Radical corrections. Some characters with radical comments but not decided at IRG#30 will be kept in D set.
 - Questionable glyph: Some discussed characters will be moved to M set, the others and newly proposed characters will be kept or moved to D set.
 - Missing character: All characters will be added to M set.
- 2 Malaysian characters will be added to M set.
- Every character moved back to M set will be marked “discussed/agreed at IRG#30” by the IRG Technical Editor.

Note: Re-location of some characters is required to the IRG Technical Editor.
