The Irish National Body has been made aware of comments in N4183 stating a concern about the font used in the code charts for the Old Hungarian script:

In the N4110 and therefore in the current PDAM 1.2 – specially ornamented glyphs are used. This style does not show any tradition of the Rovas scripting. Consequently, it is unacceptable in the standard. Since the N4110, and therefore the SC2 N 4201 uses these glyphs, none of the glyphs in the Draft Amendment (PDAM) 1.2 is adequate for encoding and therefore these glyphs are unacceptable by the Hungarian NB. The Hungarian NB can provide the necessary font for encoding the Rovas scripts.

The Irish National Body notes that these glyphs have been seen by SC2/WG2 since N3531 (2008-10-12) and no mention of this has been made previously. Glyphs are informative, of course. We have also noticed that the font in question, named “Csenge”, has long been available on the website of the author of N4183 (see <http://rovas.info/index.php/hu/letoeltese/454-fontok>). We have also seen notice including this font at [http://www.mpsz.net/index.php?option=com\\_content&view=article&id=58%3Arovasszabvanyos-betuekeszlet-dr-hosszu-gabor&limitstart=1](http://www.mpsz.net/index.php?option=com_content&view=article&id=58%3Arovasszabvanyos-betuekeszlet-dr-hosszu-gabor&limitstart=1) and the font is widely available elsewhere on the internet. And we have noticed the acknowledgement to the designer of the font made in §12 of N3697.

Nevertheless, we attach here a revised code chart which uses a more “generic” font, which should be suitable for use if the SC2/WG2 experts prefer it.
