Technical Comments:

T.1.

The U.S. requests that U+00AD SOFT HYPHEN be changed to have IGNORED for levels one, two and three in the CTT for this amendment of 14651. This will ensure that it is ignored in collation, because words should not be distinguished for searching or matching by the presence or absence of a soft hyphen. This will also keep 14651 in sync with the Unicode Collation Algorithm.
