#### D.3 Ideographic description sequences

An Ideographic Description Character (IDC) is a graphic character, which is used with a sequence of other graphic characters to form an Ideographic Description Sequence (IDS). Such a sequence may be used to describe an ideographic character which is not specified within this International Standard.

The IDS describes the ideograph in the abstract form. It is not interpreted as a composed character and does not have any rendering implication.

The twelve IDCs that are defined here are assigned to code positions 0000 0248 to 0000 0253.

#### D3.1 Syntax of an IDS

An IDS consists of an IDC followed by a fixed number of Description Components (DC). A DC may be any one of the following:

- A coded ideograph
- A coded radical
- A coded ideographic component
- Another IDS

Each IDC has 3 properties as summarized in Table-XXX below.

- The number of DCs used in the IDS that commences with that IDC,
- The definition of the proper usage of the IDC,
- The relative positions of the DCs in the visual representation of the ideograph that is being described in its abstract form.

The syntax of the IDS introduced by each IDC is indicated in the "IDS syntax" column of the table by the abbreviated name of the IDC (e.g.IDC-LTR) followed by two or three numbered DCs (DC1, DC2, DC3).
