As a part of the publication of version 3.1 of the Unicode Standard, scheduled for publication in the spring of 2001, the Unicode Consortium will be producing an update to its public Unihan database, available at its Web site (<http://www.unicode.org>).

This database includes the IRG source mappings and KangXi and Hanyu Da Zidian page numbers provided by the IRG. In addition, we request that the IRG make available radical-stroke data so that we can publish a radical-stroke chart for the entire ideographic set.

Furthermore, if there is additional data (such as pronunciation, informal mappings, alternate radical-stroke counts) which IRG members would like to provide, we would be willing to incorporate these data into the database and make them available to the general public.
