5. Passport and Visa

All participants are advised to check regulations regarding passport and visa, especially the length of notice for obtaining a visa, with their travel agency. If required, you can also contact the embassies/consulates of China at your location (please see Appendix C for embassies/consulates information in Korea and Vietnam).

It is visa-free entry to Hong Kong and Macao for passport holders of Japan, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan and U.S.A. except North Korea and Vietnam. If you need any documents for acquisition of visa, please contact the host contact (cchau.safp@informac.gov.mo) for assistance.

6. Transportation

There are two choices of transportation to Macao from your country or region:

- 1. Direct airline: from China or Taiwan;
- 2. Indirect airline: all participants except from China and Taiwan should arrive at Hong Kong Airport first, and then transport to Macao by Jetfoil or helicopter services (detail transportation is shown in Appendix D).



2. Hong Kong Airport → Hong Kong Ferry Terminal → Macao (Ferry Terminal) → Hotel

Passenger should take off at the third stop after departing from the airport, remember to press the bell when "Hong Kong-Macao Ferry Terminal" is being announced

Access to "Central" station and go to the end of terminal line as Central station → Sheung Wan station (through *Island* line)
