The Ext.C1 editorial group spent 3 days to discuss issues relating to CJK_C1 and drew the following conclusions:

Review results on N928 and CJK_C editorial schedule


The editorial group reviewed a consolidated report which was generated by IRG chief editor on the basis of IRG members' reports on N928. When reviewing this consolidated report, editors found it necessary to clarify the unification rules first to ensure high quality of CJK_C. Therefore, unification comments raised in the consolidated report were focused on. This group agreed to add some unified pairs and dis-unified pairs to the IRG N951 for unification rules as examples/references for editorial work. The editorial group listed some candidate examples (more candidate examples will be added in future) for IRG N951 for unification rules.

Other comments raised in the consolidated report, such as radical errors and stroke errors, will be rechecked by editors after this meeting.

There are 16 of 136 pairs of ideographs which are confirmed to be unified, some other pairs need character candidates submitters' rechecking to make sure that their fonts are not wrongly designed, are non-cognate or can be unified/dis-unified to others.

Schedule of future editorial work


Editors suggested a CJK_C1 editorial schedule below.



Technical editor distributes CJK C1 v2.1 to IRG editors by Dec.16, 2002.

2) IRG editors submit their comments on E1 set to Chief editor by Jan. 17, 2003 for preparing D2 set (see definition below).

3) CJK_C1 v2.2



Technical editor distributes CJK C1 v2.2 to IRG editors by Feb. 14, 2003.

- 4) IRG members submit their evidences to chief editor by Mar. 7, 2003.
- 5) Chief editor distributes consolidated evidences to IRG editors by Mar. 14, 2003.
- 6) IRG editors discuss D1 set, D2 set and M1 set at IRG#21.

Note:

Each IRG member should check their own submissions and provide evidence (such as sources, meanings, usage in context, etc.) for those characters they do not want to unify. The characters will be automatically unified if evidence cannot be given.

Editors who raised questions are required to review corresponding evidences (if provided) before IRG#21.

Editors will check CJK_C1 v2.1 and identify candidates for unification with reference to IRG N951 for unification rules. Radicals, stroke count, first stroke should also be checked.

Editors will review D2 set and provide evidences in case they do not agree with the unification.

CJK_C1 v3 will be generated after IRG#21 according to editors' decisions on D1 set, D2 set and M1 set.
