1, National bodies will provide fonts for CJK main, Ext. A, B, and C for publishing the next edition of ISO/IEC 10646.

2. Korea would like to suggest the following restrictions on using fonts provided by Korea (and possibly by other national bodies, if they like):

2.1 CJK fonts will be given to the chief project editor of ISO/IEC 10646 (currently, Mr. Michell Suignard) and can be used only for publishing the next edition of ISO/IEC 10646. He/she must not give/distribute the fonts to anybody else.

2.2 This issue is not the job of IRG. However, for your information, Korea would like to mention it. Korea would like to suggest nearly the same restrictions on using the fonts for publishing Unicode. Mr. Michell Suignard is also in charge of publishing Unicode.

CJK fonts will be given to Mr. Michell Suignard and one designated editor of Unicode (currently, Mr. John Jenkins in charge of CJK stroke charts) and can be used only for publishing the next edition of Unicode. They must not give/distribute the fonts to anybody else.
