After reviewing Vietnam's Chu Nom from BMP and Extension B, 2 Chu Nom characters are found not to be unifiable, and we have agreed to withdraw them from ISO 10646. We now resubmit them to the IRG and propose to include them into Extension E.

Checking from Kawatachi Taichi on V sources showed 2 Chu Nom characters from Extension E could be unified with those in SMP. After rechecking we agreed with Taichi's findings. We propose to add 2 mappings of the 2 Chu Nom characters into those in ISO 10646 and remove them from Extension E.
