1. Chinese delegation attended the WG2#57 for CJK issues and proposals on Chinese minorities' scripts and ancient scripts.
2. Chinese editors and experts worked on CJK\_B multi-column code charts review and Old Hanzi issues.
3. Chinese editors provided a mapping table for ZJW (《殷周金文集成引得》) characters in CJK\_E, but failed to provide more “Examples showing that the heading characters are used in different publications (not only in 殷周金文集成引得), by 2010-10-08”, because of a big project process, see item 4.
4. The Project “Chinese Characters Repertoire” is started

The Project “Chinese Characters Repertoire” (中華字庫) which had been mentioned at previous IRG meetings was officially invited public bidding by the General Administration of the Press and Publication of PRC, in October, 2010. Tens of companies, universities and organizations have bided. (Some of them are working for the Chinese delegation of IRG.)

The project is planed to be finished within 5 years. It is believed that proposals for encoding CJK ideographs and other scripts will be prepared on basis of the fruits of the project.

5. National standards of dot matrix fonts for new CJK ideographs (CJK\_C and D) are in plan.

6. China welcomes IRG members to the IRG#36 which will be hosted in Chongqing (重慶), in 2011.
