

1. Issues Related to Chinese Names of Taiwan Visitors

According to HKSARG Activity Report, the assignment of new code point <u>was not</u> necessary because the characters applied are considered unifiable with existing ISO/IEC10646 characters. And China at CJK-F is only going to submit characters of Square Zhuang Scrip (方塊壯字). There are a number of travelers from HK and China who need to apply for entry permits, and some characters of their names are not in the ISO/IEC 10646. Department of Taiwanese immigrants is required to create the characters for issuance, which causes inconvenience.
