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1. MOE had finished inspecting 4,000 T-source ideographs from TCA in April, 2014. The new ideographs will be compared with CJK-F1 after CJK-F1 are confirmed, and TCA prepares for submission to IRG.
2. Dept. of Household Registration (DHR), MOI increased 4,486 new characters. After one year of inspection and comparison, TCA find that 2,520 characters are already encoded in UCS, and 1,996 characters are not. TCA will submit to IRG after DHR reconfirms all 1,996 un-UCS coded characters' actual usage evidence.
