The latest (ISO/IEC 10646:2012 and Unicode 6.3) CJK Extension C code chart has two different glyphs at the code point U+2B08F:



It is very clear that ++ and  $\stackrel{\text{\tiny{\scale{+}}}}{\longrightarrow}$  are not unifiable.

IRG N1770 (IRG #36 resolutions) and IRG N1775 (CJK Editorial Group Report) say that the T source is to be removed from U+2B08F (and that is the reason a UCI glyph is assigned instead), but it is not removed yet.
