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1. According to an annual project from BSMI (the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection), CMEX (the Chinese Foundation for Digitization Technology) hosted two meetings for discussing the issues of revising CNS 11643:2007, on March 31th and April 22th, respectively. For those meetings, CMEX invited representatives of the organizations that use CNS 11643 and the experts of Chinese characters, and they made some following major suggestions about the revision of CNS 11643:

1) For the Chinese characters of CNS 11643:2007 with different sharps form CNS 11643:1992, changes most of them back to the sharps of version 1992. such as:

CNS11643-1992 膳 CNS11643-2007 膳

2) For the next version of CNS 11643, collects possibly all non-CNS 11643 Chinese characters from the full repertoire of Chinese characters owned by the National Development Council.

- 3) Before revising CNS 11643:2007, make efforts to check all existing Chinese characters for duplications and wrong attributes such as radicals, as possible.

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
