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- 1. The UK has been actively reviewing and providing feedback on IRG Working Set 2015 Version 3.0.
- 2. A number of experts working with us have suggested a large number of CJK characters from a wide variety of sources as candidates for encoding. We are currently reviewing these candidates, and expect to include about 1,500 to 2,000 of them in the next UK submission to IRG. Most of these characters are used in Chinese dialects, in place names, as family names, or as transcriptions for Old Hanzi characters. Up to 500 characters are simplified forms of existing CJK unified ideographs.
- 3. The UK would like to work with interested parties on a proposal to encode additional CJK components that are required for IDS use.
