

# Universal Coded Character Set UCS

**Title:** Recommendation to solicit review of IRG working set submissions prior to submission

This document recommends that IRG member bodies consider soliciting feedback from IRG experts prior to IRG working set submission, in order to increase the overall quality of submissions, and to avoid the 5% rule that can cause submissions to be rejected.

## Recommendation

Developing IRG working set submissions is a lot of work with a lot of moving parts, which means that the possibility of error is relatively high. No submission is without error, and given the 5% rule that applies to submissions, which can lead to a submission being administratively rejected, IRG member bodies are therefore strongly encouraged to solicit feedback on their IRG working set submissions prior to submission.

As examples, the UTC solicited feedback from IRG experts on the repertoire of their submission prior to submission for IRG Working Set 2024, and the UK solicited feedback on their overall submission prior to submission.

## Next Steps

Although the current submission period ended on 2024-07-26, IRG member bodies should consider this recommendation for the next IRG working set.
