The reason we missed the unification in previous IDS check was the outer part of right component, which is a very common variant of 虎, is not in UCV list. It is a variant of 虍 per Korean normalization rule 130-1, which postdates the standardization of the Extension F in which U+2E23A is encoded. Should the rule have been in effect, the component would have been normalized to 虍. Furthermore, the current Korean source's glyph in the system also shows an exact match to the glyph.

As working set 2021 has been submitted to WG2 and compiled as Extension J at this stage, the unification should be done by submitting ballot comments to WG2. Thus, we request TCA and ROK consider this unification case, and if proper, submitting ballot comments to an upcoming WG2 meeting.

Also, regardless of the unification result, I suggest adding the 虍 variants to UCV in the upcoming IRG 63 meeting.
