Item 1

In IRG N2786, it was pointed out the current shape of U+980B (T3-4552) and U+2F9FE (T6-5A33) is identical:



However, the original glyph from WG2 N2159, T3-4552 has the first stroke 撤, and T6-5A33 has the first stroke 横:

In IRG N2779 page 31, the glyph of T6-5A33 is changed to first stroke 撇 instead:

This appears to be in error.

Action Item 1:

- U+980B (T3-4552) should be changed to first stroke 撇
 - This makes the glyph identical with the original submission, and also makes the glyph consistent with Kangxi Dictionary, JMJ, and KP1.
- U+2F9FE (T6-5A33) should be kept with first stroke 橫 (no change)

Item 2:

In IRG N2779 page 14, during the meeting it was mentioned that the old glyph and new glyph would be swapped:



i.e. U+288B1 would be changed to ⊟□知于酉, instead of ⊟□知子酉.

However, ⊟□知于酉 is already encoded as U+288AE:

Which is already mapped to TB-3077:



Therefore, the form of T7-4436 should be kept using $\Box\Box$ 知子酉, matching the original proposal.

Action Item 2:

No change necessary to the original proposal: keep U+288B1 (T7-4436) using 子.

Item 3:

In IRG N2779 page 9, the following glyph change is proposed:



However, U+2096F is under radical 23, not radical 22 in the Code Charts.

Per the character in the original source 《字彙補》, this character should be under radical 23 "匸", not radical 22 "匚" (see arrow 1).

However, the text of the MOE Variants Dictionary has noted it as radical 22 "□" in error (see arrow 2).





This character is filed under radical 23 and not radical 22, despite the inconsistent shape of the typesetter.

Action Item 3:

- The text in MOE Variants Dictionary to be corrected to radical 23
- The radical of 6-236F in CNS11643 to be corrected to radical 23 (if it was changed)
- The glyph of T6-236F to be updated to use radical 23


Item 4:
