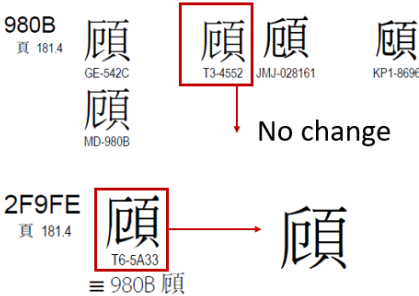

N2832 mentioned 4 T-glyph issues, and TCA provides the following explanations.

For Item1:

MOE has swapped the standard and variant forms of these two characters.

- The first stroke of **T3-4552** is a **horizontal stroke(橫)**.
- The first stroke of **T6-5A33** is a **丿 stroke (撇)**.



For Item2:

This was already explained in the #64 meeting. Please refer to IRGN2779R2 (Appendix 1 No.106).

For Item3:

Thank you to Eiso(in Webox chat) and Henry for identifying this issue. TCA urgently discussed with MOE, and based on the original reference 字彙補, the radical 23.0 (匚) for Codechart U+2096F is correct. Therefore, the glyph of U+2096F (T6-236F) has already been modified to "匚" in R2. Please refer to IRGN2779R2 (Appendix 1 No.31).

For Item4:

The glyphs of T3-2623 and T3-2D56 will not be normalized, and it is confirmed that the first stroke of 壬 should be a 丿 stroke (撇).

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
