Title: Resolutions of IRG #7

The IRG resolves the following:

1. Vertical Extension Levels I, II, and III, mentioned in document N317, are to be renamed CJK Unified Ideograph Extensions A, B, and C, respectively. (Passed unanimously)

2. The IRG accepts the report of the Editorial Working Group (N369) and approves its schedule. (Passed unanimously)

3. IRG members strongly request that CJK Unified Ideograph Extension A v. 1.0 (N380) be included in ISO/IEC 10646, because:

a. These characters are used in national standards and/or specifications;

b. These ideographs are widely used;

c. Most are used by more than one member; and

d. It is a minimum acceptable set to members for efficient processing.

(Passed unanimously)

IRG members further request that CJK Unified Ideograph Extension A v. 1.0 be encoded in the BMP because:

e. These characters are used in national standards and/or specifications;

f. These ideographs are widely used;

g. Most are used by more than one member;

h. It is a minimum acceptable set to members for efficient processing.

- i. There is enough room in the BMP; and
 - j. The IRG will not request the inclusion of other ideograph sets in the BMP in the future.
(China, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, and TCA approved; Unicode disapproved; Vietnam abstained.)
4. The IRG will request the inclusion of CJK Ideograph Extensions B and C, as well as other ideographs, in future versions of ISO/IEC 10646. (Passed unanimously)
 5. The S-column proposed for CJK Unified Ideograph Extension A is to be merged with the G-column. (Passed unanimously)
 6. Members will supply high-quality fonts for IS/HS (96 x 96 bitmaps or TrueType) to the Editor by 31 July 1996. (Passed unanimously)
 7. The IRG volunteers to print the Unified Ideographic Repertoire of the next edition of ISO/IEC 10646 using the said high-quality fonts. (Passed unanimously)
 8. The next Rapporteur of the IRG is to be Zhang Zhoucai. (Passed unanimously)
 9. The following are to be submitted to WG2 for inclusion in ISO/IEC 10646:
 - a. Revised text for Clause 26 of ISO/IEC 10646 (N362)
 - b. Revised text for Annex S of ISO/IEC 10646 (N363)
 - c. IS/HS v. 6.0 (N371)
 - d. New Annex on and description of CJK Unified Ideograph Extension A
(Passed unanimously)
 10. The following are to be submitted to WG2 for inclusion in the BMP of ISO/IEC 10646:
 - a. Ideographic Structure Characters (N365 with attachment)
 - b. Ideographic Variation Mark (N366 with attachment)
 - c. Ideographic Radical Supplement (N367 with attachment)
 - d. Ideographic Component Supplement (N368 with attachment)
(Japan abstained on a and b)

11. All future IRG communications are to be by e-mail as well as fax and regular mail. (Passed unanimously)

12. Future meetings of the IRG are to be held as follows:

a. IRG 8: Singapore, 13–17 January 1997

b. IRG 9: China, summer 1997 (to be confirmed)
(Passed unanimously)

13. In view of the complexity and importance of the IRG's proposals to WG2, the IRG urges its members to participate in WG2 meetings, particularly WG2 #31 (Canada) and WG2 #32 (Singapore). (Passed unanimously)

14. The IRG thanks the Chinese University of Hong Kong, HKITF, Dr. Lu Chin, Mr. Lee Kin-hong, Mr. Wong Man Fai, Ms. Yao Jian, Ms. Lam Yuk, Mr. Nui Pei Tak, and other staff in the Faculty of Engineering and the Department of Computer Science and Engineering. (Passed unanimously by acclamation)
