**Title: Resolutions of 4th JTC 1/SC2 Plenary Meeting
held in Athens on May 27-28, 1993**

1. Resolution: Appointment of SC2 Chairman

JTC 1/SC2 endorses the appointment of Mr. Sten Lindberg as SC2 Chairman.

unanimous

2. Resolution: Title and Scope of SC2

JTC 1/SC2 endorses the following title and scope of its work.

Title: Coded Character Sets

Scope: Standardization of graphic character sets and their characteristics, associated control functions, their coded representation for information interchange, and code extension techniques. Excluded: audio and picture coding.

3. Resolution: WG2 Ideographic Rapporteur Group

JTC 1/SC2 endorses the formation of the Ideographic Rapporteur Group (IRG) according to the following:

Objective

To establish a unified repertoire and ordering of East Asian ideographic characters for the future extension of ISO/IEC 10646.

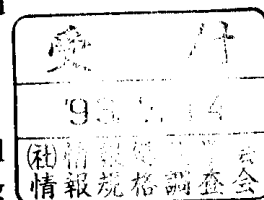
Membership

WG2/IRG consists of experts nominated by a national body of SC2, and individual experts and organizations nominated by SC2/WG2.

Process

Technical contributions shall be forwarded to SC2/WG2; the internal organization of WG2/IRG shall be decided on the basis of consensus among the members of WG2/IRG.

4. Resolution: Character Names

JTC 1/SC2 confirms that the programme of work for WG2 includes the development and maintenance of a coherent list of graphic character names. The programme of work for WG3 includes liaison with WG2 when assigning names to graphic characters and control functions. ISO/IEC 10646 shall be used as the reference document for character names. Defect reports that relate to character names shall be sent to the SC2 Secretariat for distribution.

5. Resolution: Liaison with IEC/SC3B

JTC 1/SC2 endorses the establishment of a formal relationship of liaison between SC2/WG3 and IEC/SC3B.

6. Resolution: Liaison with Unicode

JTC 1/SC2 endorses the establishment of a formal relationship of liaison, Category C, between SC2/WG2 and Unicode, Inc. and instructs its Secretariat to forward the statement of benefits and responsibilities (SC2 document N 2459) to JTC 1.

approved; 1 negative: Belgium

7. Resolution: Liaison with CEN/TC304

JTC 1/SC2 endorses the establishment of a formal relationship of liaison, Category C, between SC2/WG2 and CEN/TC304 and instructs its Secretariat to forward the statement of benefits and responsibilities (SC2 document N 2465) to JTC 1.

8. Resolution: Liaison with AFII

JTC 1/SC2 endorses the establishment of a formal relationship of liaison, Category C, between SC2/WG2 and AFII and instructs its Secretariat to forward the statement of benefits and responsibilities (SC2 document N 2435) to JTC 1.

approved; 1 negative: Belgium

9. Resolution: Liaison with Internet

JTC 1/SC2 instructs its Secretariat to forward a request for a statement of benefits and responsibilities for a Category C liaison to Internet, and upon receipt, issue a letter ballot which includes their response.

10. Resolution: Liaison with SHARE Europe

JTC 1/SC2 instructs its Secretariat to forward a request for a statement of benefits and responsibilities for a Category C liaison to SHARE Europe, and upon receipt, issue a letter ballot which includes their response.

unanimous

11. Resolution: Liaison Statement to TC46

JTC 1/SC2 instructs its Secretariat to prepare and forward a liaison statement to ISO/TC46 to the following effect: For purposes of alignment and harmonization, JTC 1/SC2 asks ISO/TC46 to send their Committee Drafts and DISs relating to coded character sets to JTC 1/SC2 for comments and guidance.

12. Resolution: Affirmation of Responsibility for Coded Character Sets

JTC 1/SC2 requests that JTC 1 seek confirmation from ISO and IEC that JTC 1/SC2 is their sole committee responsible for the standardization of coded character sets. For purposes of alignment and harmonization, JTC 1/SC2 invites members of other committees in ISO and IEC to contribute proposals for coded character sets and work item proposals for comments and guidance from SC2.

13. Resolution: Periodical Review

JTC 1/SC2 resolves to revise the following standards:

- ISO 2022, to make it more convenient to use as a reference document.
- All parts of ISO/IEC 8859, to align character names and conformance clauses for consistency with ISO/IEC 10646, and to adjust 'field of application' where necessary.
- ISO 9036, to align character names with ISO/IEC 10646.
- ISO/IEC 10367, to align character names with ISO/IEC 10646.
- ISO/IEC 10538, to align with ISO/IEC 6429 regarding bi-directional control functions.

14. Resolution: Status of the Project JTC 1.02.18

JTC 1/SC2 notes that the second DIS has been approved, and the ISO/IEC 10646-1 International Standard has been published on May 1, 1993. Regarding the specific information as requested by JTC 1 in document JTC 1 N2530, JTC 1/SC2 instructs its Secretariat to prepare and forward a response based on the following text:

- Change of the title: The title of the first DIS was "Information technology - Universal Coded Character Set (UCS)". The title of the second DIS is "Information technology - Universal Multiple-Octet Coded Character Set (UCS)". The change was made to resolve a comment from The Netherlands for the first DIS which requested clarification of the fact that this is a multiple-octet coded character set.

- **Change of the designation:** The designation of the second DIS is "Part 1: Architecture and Basic Multilingual Plane." It was changed to resolve a comment by Belgium on the first DIS to make the future maintenance of the Standard simple in the spirit of a note in 6.13.2.1 of the JTC 1 Directives. Additional parts of ISO/IEC 10646 can be used for additional coded character planes which can be used to allocate additional characters. In order to do this, it is not necessary to make changes, reviews, or to republish the contents of Part 1.

These changes were agreed by the SC2 Plenary Meeting in Rennes in 1991 and are reflected in resolutions 3 and 13 of SC2 N2296

15. Resolution: Registration of Subrepertoires

JTC 1/SC2 instructs its Secretariat to invite National Bodies to send their requirements on subrepertoires to the Swedish National Body (SIS-ITS) to enable it to prepare a statement of purpose and justification for the registration of subrepertoires

JTC 1/SC2 makes the following appointments, effective this date:

National Bodies are invited to submit additional nominations for project editors.
