RESOLUTION M 23-01: SC 2 Business Plan

SC 2 confirms its Business Plan contained in SC 2 N 4617 and approves its submission to the JTC 1 Plenary Meeting to be held in Stockholm, Sweden, 2018-11-05/09 with modifications to reflect the result of this meeting. The SC 2 National Bodies and Liaison organizations are invited to submit any additional input or editorial suggestions to the SC 2 Chairman by 2018-09-15.

RESOLUTION M 23-02: Progression of Project for Amendment 1 to ISO/IEC 10646 (Ed.5)

SC 2 approves the disposition of comments in Document SC 2 N 4620 (WG 2 N 4952R) on ISO/IEC 10646/DAM 1. SC 2 instructs the Project Editor to prepare a revised text reflecting the changes arising from the disposition of comments for FDAM processing. The target date for submission of FDAM text to ITTF is: 2018-08.

RESOLUTION M 23-03: Progression of Project for Amendment 2 to ISO/IEC 10646 (Ed.5)

SC 2 approves the disposition of comments in Document SC 2 N 4621 (WG 2 N 4995) on ISO/IEC 10646/PDAM 2.3 and the additional changes described in Recommendations M67.05 and M67.06 adopted at the WG 2 meeting.

SC 2 instructs its Secretary to submit this proposal for a new edition to JTC 1 for endorsement.

Adopted with Abstentions of Japan and Korea on Recommendation M67.13, UK on Recommendation M67.17.

RESOLUTION M23-05: Progression of ISO/IEC 10646 (Ed 6)

SC 2 instructs its Secretary to initiate a CD ballot when a text is submitted by the Project Editor. The ballot period (8, 12, or 16 weeks) will be decided by the Project Editor. SC 2 delegates its authority to WG 2 for disposition of comments on the CD and subsequent ballots and a recommendation for further processing until the next plenary. The target dates for submission of ballot texts are: CD 2018-09, CD2 2019-01, DIS 2019-07.

RESOLUTION M23-06: Additions to CD before next WG 2 meeting

SC 2 notes that some scripts and additional characters which are under preparation as potential additions could become mature and will have consensus among WG 2 experts to include in the subsequent CD texts as described in WG 2 Recommendations M67.22 to M67.24 below.

RESOLUTION M23.07: Mongolian

SC 2 notes the progress made by the Mongolian experts in Document SC 2 N 4626 (WG 2 N 4989) and N 4998, and invites the Chinese national body, working with Mongolian experts, to prepare and submit to WG 2, a separate document containing only the proposed additions with rationale and phonetic information.

RESOLUTION M23.08: Small Seal script

SC 2 notes the progress made by the experts in Document SC 2 N 4627 (WG 2 N 4973) as described in WG 2 Recommendation M67.28 and encourages the experts to continue the work towards a contribution for encoding the script, taking into account the feedback documents and discussion at this meeting, and to submit to WG 2. SC 2 notes that another ad hoc meeting of experts is planned by TCA in November, 2018 (tentatively), and invites all the interested experts to take note towards planning to attend the meeting.

RESOLUTION M 23-09: Indian national body Proposal for inclusion of Assamese script in ISO/IEC 10646

In response to the contribution of India in Document SC 2 N 4600, SC 2 accepts WG 2 ad hoc meeting report on Assamese script in Document SC 2 N 4628 (WG 2 N 4999) as described in WG 2 Recommendation M67.25. SC 2 encourages the experts on Assamese Script to continue the work towards a revised contribution and submit to WG 2. SC 2 invites the national body of India, BIS, to coordinate this effort.
